



RESOLUTION 2026-09

A RESOLUTION DECLARING OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES FROM PROCEEDS OF BORROWING

BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HOBART, WISCONSIN:

WHEREAS, the Village of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin (the "Issuer") plans to acquire land and construct a municipal building thereon (the "Project");

WHEREAS, the Issuer expects to finance the Project on a long-term basis by issuing tax-exempt notes or other tax-exempt obligations (collectively, the "Notes");

WHEREAS, because the Notes will not be issued prior to commencement of the Project, the Issuer must provide interim financing to cover costs of the Project incurred prior to receipt of the proceeds of the Notes; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board (the "Governing Body") of the Issuer deems it to be necessary, desirable, and in the best interests of the Issuer to advance moneys from its funds on hand on an interim basis to pay the costs of the Project until the Notes are issued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hobart, Brown County, that:

Section 1. Expenditure of Funds. The Issuer shall make expenditures as needed from its funds on hand to pay the cost of the Project until proceeds of the Notes become available.

Section 2. Declaration of Official Intent. The Issuer hereby officially declares its intent under Treas. Reg. Section 1.150-2 to reimburse said expenditures with proceeds of the Notes, the principal amount of which is not expected to exceed \$1,000,000.

Section 3. Unavailability of Long-Term Funds. No funds for payment of the Project from sources other than the Notes are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside by the Issuer pursuant to its budget or financial policies.

Section 4. Public Availability of Official Intent Resolution. The Resolution shall be made available for public inspection at the office of the Issuer's Clerk within 30 days after its approval in compliance with applicable State law governing the availability of records of official

acts including Subchapter II of Chapter 19, and shall remain available for public inspection until the Notes are issued.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption and approval.
