Reduce speed limit on Trout Creek Road from 45 MPH to 35 MPH between Riverdale Road and Overland Road

#### **Background**

- 1) With the development of the Thornberry Creek and Polo Point neighborhoods, the amount of foot and bicycle traffic has increased on Trout Creek Road. The speed limit on this road is currently set at 45 MPH, and many motorists exceed that limit. <u>This presents a safety issue</u> since there are no walking or biking paths at this time.
- 2) The speed limit on Overland Road from Trout Creek and north is already at 35 MPH.
- 3) Areas along Trout Creek continue to be developed, which will undoubtedly add to the foot and bike traffic.
